Homemade Bubble Solution

Description:

This easy homemade bubble solution creates strong, colorful bubbles that are perfect for backyard fun. Whether you're blowing bubbles with a wand or making giant bubbles with homemade tools, this simple mixture is inexpensive and easy to prepare.

INGREDIENTS

Bubble Solution

- 8 cups water
- 1/2 cup blue dish soap (such as Dawn)
- 1/4 cup light corn syrup

RHINO TIP



For the biggest, longest-lasting bubbles, allow the mixture to rest overnight before using. Patience makes a noticeable difference!

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

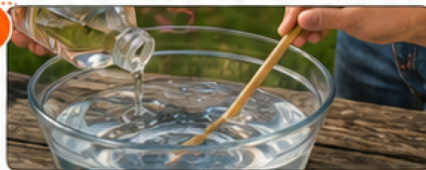
1



Combine the water and soap.

Pour the water into a large bowl or container. Add the dish soap and stir gently to combine. Avoid creating too many bubbles while mixing.

2



Add the corn syrup.

Stir the corn syrup into the mixture slowly until fully incorporated.

3



Let the solution rest.

Cover the container and let the solution rest for at least 4 hours or overnight. This helps create stronger, longer-lasting bubbles.

4



Use the bubble solution.

Pour the solution into smaller containers and use with bubble wands, straws, or homemade giant bubble tools.

5



Store leftovers.

Keep leftover bubble solution in a sealed container for future use.

TIPS & VARIATIONS



1. Giant Bubbles – Use two sticks and a loop of cotton string to create enormous bubbles outdoors.



2. Bubble Refill Station – Pour the solution into small containers or recycled bubble bottles for easy refills and sharing.



3. Bubble Foam Fun – Whisk a small amount of solution with water to make bubbly foam for sensory play.



4. Bubble Art – Add a few drops of washable food coloring and blow bubbles onto paper to create colorful designs.



5. Frozen Bubbles – Try blowing bubbles outside on very cold days to observe how they freeze and form delicate patterns.
